

Affidavit of Accused Peabody Teacher Released

Judge approves release of the affidavit of the Peabody-Burns High School social studies teacher, Christopher Young, who is accused of having sexual relations with two students from the same high school.

Affiant Chief of Police, Bruce Burke, was advised that a teacher, Young, at Peabody-Burns High School was having sexual relations with a student attending the school.

A friend of the victim provides also a written statement detailing the nuances of the crime. The friend reports that the victim's boyfriend would typically come to her house on weekends, crawling through her bedroom window at 10 pm and crawling out of her bedroom window between 2-3 am.

In late January, the Peabody Police Department, and Marion County Sheriff's office executed a search warrant at the school for Young's cell phone. Young refused to sign the search warrant, also opting not to say anything without his attorney being present.

The victim's father refuses to subject her to any interview on the situation for he states that there are attributing factors at play: 'emotions and feelings.' The father asserts further that 'everything [Burke] needs' is on his daughter's phone.

Chief Burke discovered the following on the victim's phone: (partial) nude photos of both parties and the following sent message: "'Pretty good, I'm fucking my History teacher and the head cheerleader at this school, my dad's the head drug dealer and moonshine maker of the town so I've got it all made.'"

Subsequent to consenting to a Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner/Sexual Assault Response Team (SANE/SART), the victims disclose that Chris Young had ejaculated three times inside of her, and twice inside of the other victim.
