

Young Charged on Eight Felony Charges

45-year-old Christopher Young has been charged with eight felony charges after alleged sexual relations with two former students at Peabody-Burns High School.

The court made the sentencing after Young turned himself in with a request of a bond for \$150,000 to be lowered. The court accepted the negotiation under the circumstances that he will only pay \$50,000 compared to the 100,000 if he didn't show up. Young's defense attorney John Rapp said, "I've had no problems getting hold of Mr. Young."

The court also stated that Young was required to sign a waiver of extradition in case he was to leave the state and be captured somewhere else.

Young was a Social Studies teacher at Peabody-Burns High, and according to county attorney Courtney Boehm he received 5 counts of "unlawful sexual relations, consensual sexual intercourse, lewd fondling and touching."

The sexual acts took place with 16 years old students. An affidavit that was released to the public that relationship between Young and one of the girl extended as far as Chris breaking up with his girlfriends to have an active relationship with the student.

One student even had an encounter where Young went and got the girl from her house and she said stayed the night in his trailer. He even drove her to school the morning.

Young faces eight felony charges and will be headed to prison for a very long time.
