

Social studies teacher and coach from Peabody-Burns High School has been charged with eight felony complaints in sex-related offenses towards two students. Christopher Young has been having sexual relations with a student, engaging in sexual texts, pictures and videos as well as unacceptable behavior caught Peabody-Burns security cameras. The Marion County Sheriff's Office has been notified of this situation and is cooperating in a joint investigation due to crimes being committed in multiple jurisdictions. Peabody-Burns U.S.D. #398 School Administration has been notified and is cooperating fully with the investigation, which includes monitoring the video system at Peabody-Burns Jr.-Sr. High School. The high school has caught evidence of Christopher Young's locked classroom door on school mornings and engaging with the student in hallways and classrooms alone together when the student has other places should be in the school. Law Enforcement has also received information another student has also had inappropriate sexual relations with Christopher Young. A search warrant has been issued to seize Christopher Young's phone after he refused to hand over his cell phone to the police. On his cell phone there is the evidence that was analyzed found two partially nude pictures of the second student, a text message, and a nude picture of the two together at Christopher Young's residence. In the statement issued, it has also been said that in December 2017 Christopher Young had one of the students spend the night in his trailer. Later that year on February 13th, an interview for one of the two students was conducted where she revealed that herself, the other student, and Christopher all had sex together and where she also confirmed her identity in the photos taken from Christopher Young's phone after forensic analyzing.
