## *7.1 earthquake rocks Mexico City & Central Mexico*

### **“The whole room started shaking,”**

said Adrian Wilson, a photographer from New York City when a magnitude 7.1 earthquake struck the central Mexican state of Puebla on Tuesday afternoon.

Reports put the epicenter of the earthquake 2.8 miles northeast of San Raboso and 34.1 miles southwest of the Puebla. The earthquake was felt in the center of Mexico City, 75 miles from the epicenter, striking at a depth of 33 miles. There were no immediate injury reports, but reports of damaged buildings.

Wilson claimed that the earthquake “seemed like a truck was going over a manhole and the building was slightly shaking,” until “it just magnified and magnified and the whole room was shaking.”

President Enrique Pena Nieto called a meeting for the National Emergency Committee to evaluate the overall situation.
